

Facts About Connecticut's Transportation Spending

- Connecticut spends \$497,659 per mile of road, the 44th highest rate in the country, according to a study by the Reason Foundation.
- Connecticut spends \$99,417 per mile in administrative costs alone, the highest rate in the country
- Connecticut has the 6th highest gas tax in the country
- Transportation revenue has grown 20 percent since 2000 when adjusted for inflation
- Connecticut drivers would pay 71 percent of the \$1 billion in toll revenue per year, according to a 2015 state study
